Blackfriar is one of three ancient orders of monks central to the history of Perth in Scotland. The monastery of the Blackfriar was built in 1231. In 1437 James I of Scotland was assassinated by traitors there.

## WHAT DOES THE BEER TASTE LIKE?

A dark brew, hardy and warming, with a slightly sweet malty character balanced by a pleasant hoppiness. Blackfriar is known as a 'wee heavy' a term used in Scotland for generations to describe strong ales. Many 'wee heavies' were amongst the first beers to be exported in the early 1800's.
